



**2017 Y-Bridge Arts Festival
August 4th & 5th , 2017**

Protocol for participating artists arrival at the Zane's Landing Park

1. Artists may arrive 10 a.m. , Friday August 4th.
2. Upon arrival artists must register at the Welcome Tent (located at the entrance of Landing).
3. Artists will be given an artist packet with attached Parking Pass.
4. Volunteers will be available. They will have access to hand carts, loading of art work and booth equipment from the artist's vehicle.
5. Your vehicle cannot remain in the artist tent area or welcome area for extended periods of time. The volunteers will help you unload, give you your parking pass, you move your car to assigned parking area. Parking is usually in the Ballas Egg Employee parking. That space will not be open for us until 4 p.m. The volunteer will bring you back to Welcome Tent and help you move your art items to your tent.
6. During the festival, volunteers are available to sit artists' booths for short periods of time for lunch and restroom breaks. Volunteers will not sell any of your art during your absence. You will need to provide the volunteer with "message" to use while you are away. Contact the welcome tent when you want to schedule a volunteer.
7. Booth must remain open until dark, Friday, August 4th. Some lighting is provided for the tents.
8. Booth must be open by 11 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 5th and remain open until 9 p.m.
9. Tent flaps will be closed when festival is closed. Zanesville City Police will be present during that time.
10. Zanesville Police will be on duty during all of the festival.
11. At closing of festival on Saturday, Aug. 5th, at 9 pm for the artists. Band has been booked for later...
12. Volunteers will help you transport items to artists' vehicles. Please follow their instructions to get you out in a timely manner.
13. If you have your own carts and don't need volunteers to help with loading and unloading, contact the Welcome tent.
14. We have never experience a storm or heavy rain at any of our festivals.. I encourage you to have a plan B for your art in event of inclimate weather.
15. The festival is for celebration of the arts and keeping a positive and public friendly atmosphere. We are asking our artists and vendors to not wear or display political publicity. The same is true for any solicitation for petitions or donations for particular causes.
16. Thank you for participating in this years' festival. As a participating artist, you are also invited to be a participant in the 2018 Y Bridge Arts Festival.
